




Common Narrative about Manuscripts and Print:

- A one-way narrative: from manuscript to print
- Print becomes the main medium for cultural dissemination in the 16th century
- Manuscripts fall into oblivion, except for private use or to evade censorship
- Palaeography ceases to be a discipline
- Same for codicology
- Book history (i.e., the history of printed books) takes over









Manuscript Collections 1575-1800


- Manuscripts Produced by Professionals
- In abundance
- All genres: scientific, theatre, satire, song lyrics, translations, history, manuals
- Where do they come from? Why were they produced? Who were they intended for? How did they end up being used?












Project's objectives

- Study a large number of manuscripts to analyse manuscript culture at a time when it was supposedly no longer present
- Understand materiality through modern codicology
- Understand the evolution of handwriting through modern palaeography (or neography?)
- Understand textuality through the philology of modern manuscripts
- Understand places of production: monasteries, schools, academies...
- Understand the market in relation to literacy and cultural circles
- Understand the audience to rethink the culture of the Italian Ancien Régime
















A layered corpus

- Gallica: 1.200 records








18K mss * 70% = 12.600 relevant records


Extracted region from page

Ink-free watermark image (FPT Project)




Synthetically inked with ink density



























INPUT: Synthetically inked sample
