

When dealing with paper one deals with watermarks. Nearly from the beginning of paper production in Europe, probably as long ago as the early 12th century, watermarks have been used to indicate a paper's origin or quality. They indicate the town and the factory, or at first the paper mill, where the paper was made.

Watermarks in Digital Collections is an international workshop organized by the Austrian Academy of Sciences and the Subdirecció General de Conservació, Restauració e Investigació IVC+R de CulturArts Generalitat. The aim of this workshop is to bring together watermark and paper experts and to focus on watermark databases available on the internet and their relation with the **portal Bernstein – The Memory of Paper** (<http://www.memoryofpaper.eu>). Further topics will be the project WZIS (<http://www.wasserzeichen-online.de>), standardization and classification, IPH, watermark recording, and other issues concerning watermarks.
