




Paper mill in Staré Hory



- One pair of watermarks in book block= twins





Both bookbinding have Ghotick character – wooden bords, covered by aluminium tanned laether, with brass fittings.

- 300 x 450 mm » Recute (Chancery 310 x 440)
- Several types of watermarks in pair = twins
- Small ranges of archival records



There is also one pair of watermarks depicting a ladder with six pointed star in this manuscript. Briquet wrote about exclusively italian watermarks.






Crossbow in circle with flower lily is from Venice according to Briquet, and adds this watermark is on paper with large dimension.



In first half of 16th century another places was added This place is Augsburg. So before the paper mill in Staré Hory near Jihlava the papers was bought predominently from Italy and from 15th century from Germany.
