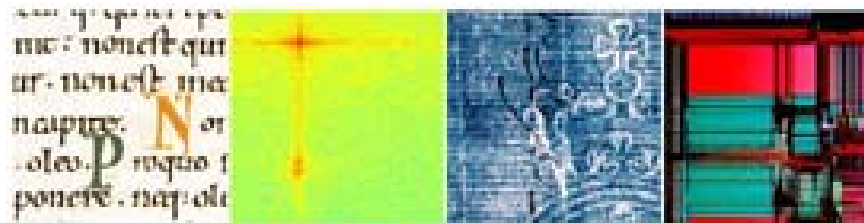

# Financial statement

## Eligible costs

### – Direct costs

- Personnel
- Subcontracting
- Travel and subsistence expenses
- Other specific costs

e.g. costs for the organisation of workshops and conferences, Web site hosting, Web site, design, printing, translation, the acquisition of software licenses, ...

### – Indirect costs

flat rate basis amounting to up to 30% of the personnel costs

## Non-eligible costs

e.g. indirect taxes and duties, including VAT (unless the *beneficiary* can show that he is unable to recover it),

entertainment or hospitality expenses
